Tree, Bush and Vegetation Trimming by Al's Affordable Tree Care
WEEK OF AUGUST 15, 2016

WHEN TRIMMING, AL'S WILL DEFINITELY NEED TO HAVE ALL VEGETATION BACK PAST THE ROAD EDGES. ALSO, ALL TREES AND BUSHES NEED TO BE AT LEAST 16' TO 18' ABOVE THE ROAD SURFACE. AL'S HAS BEEN THROUGH THE TOWN AND HERE IS WHAT NEEDS TO BE DONE ON THE MUNICIPAL STREETS.

HOPKINS STREET: Trim the tree 3/4's of the way down the street on left across from light pole.

COMMUNITY LANE: Trim trees up and back for trucks to dump to the end of the asphalt paving, including bushes on the opposite side of the Community House.

FIRST STREET: Trim a few limbs back on trees located on street.

SCHOOL ROAD: No Trimming Required.

SAILOR'S PATH: Trim trees up and back for trucks to dump to the end of lot #17.

MOORE STREET: Trim the spruce and cedar back a little at the cul-de-sac and tell homeowners to pull their flowers off the road.

SOUTH STREET: Trim back trees and bushes on both sides.

COLBOURNE LANE: Trim back trees and bushes, especially at the end.

WEST STREET: Trim back trees at side and overhead.

PINE STREET: Trim trees up and back, the length of the street.

SHADY LANE: Trim trees and bushes back.

LEWIS STREET: Trim trees and bushes back (NOTE: Do not do anything to the dogwood near 504 Vine)

MAIN STREET: No trimming required.
