BETHEL TOWN COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, October 4, 2016

The meeting was called to order by President Jeff Hastings at 7:00 P.M. President Hastings led the meeting in the Pledge of Allegiance. Present were Council members Anna Lee Robinson, Mary McCoy, Kevin Phillips and Mark Shaver. Attorney Julianne Murray was present as was Judy Schwartz from GMB Engineering. Students from Salisbury University doing the Financial Review were also present.

Bio Retention Update: Judy Schwartz from GMB Engineering to give an update of the Bio Retention work. She has been working with the contractor since July on the punch list of things that need to be done. Weeds were a concern, especially in the triangle area. Ms. Schwartz said weeding is not part of the contract, just the maintenance of the plants as to establish the health and viability of the plants.

There was discussion of dead plants, including in the island. Under the warranty, dead plants should be replaced. Replacement is done at the one year anniversary. Majority of the plants were done in January, and then came back in early spring.

McCoy had asked about settling the remaining bills and getting the remaining funds to pay this bill. Schwartz said that she can't request a disbursement until the work is done. Schwartz recommendation was to withhold some payment until the work is complete. All the initial work is done and the only issue is the weeding. Attorney Murray said she would provide GMB written confirmation of the legal interpretation of the weeding issue. Also, start date of the contract was also an issue.

Secretary's Report: McCoy needed clarification on the paving action at Museum Circle as to who made the motion. The amount was \$7,463. McCoy will make the correction.

Motion made by Robinson, seconded by Shaver to accept the Minutes for the September 6 meeting with the clarification of the Museum Circle/Road vote and the cost of the project. Motion passed unanimously.

Town Clerk Report: (Copy attached) Action was taken on the Open Data Portal beyond what is already collected by the state. The cost of the databases is \$400 per year. Motion made by McCoy, seconded by Shaver to not participate in the Open Data Portal since it is not really for a town as small as our Motion passed unanimously.

Halloween: Laurel is celebrating Monday, October 31 6pm to 8pm. Bethel traditionally follows what Laurel does for Halloween McCoy made a motion to celebrate Trick or Treating on Monday, October 31 6pm to 8pm. Seconded by Robinson, motion passed unanimously.

New Microphones and Audio System: Our current system is very antiquated and according to the electronics person, it is junk. The new system is 1000 watts. The old one was 150 watts. We will have mixer board instead of an amplifier. We will also be able to use the hand held microphone. The cost of the system is \$984 with a 10% discount, with puts the price around \$900. Hank Graves had information on digital system. The technician said wireless is probably not needed with the occasional use. Phillips recommendation is to use Seaford Music. Motion made McCoy to accept \$984 less 10% from Seaford Music for the 1000 watt system. Motion seconded by Shaver, motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Bills to be paid (see attached). Motion made by Phillips, seconded by Robinson to accept the bills to be paid as read. Motion passed unanimously.

Treasurer's Report (see attached). Motion made by Robinson, seconded by Phillips to accept the Treasurer's Report. Motion passed unanimously.

Tax Update: 95% of the taxes have been returned.

Building Permits: Ordinance 10-4-2016 (copy attached) Phillips did the first reading. Phillips had a question about demolition permit and whether that fits into the Sec.2-2 a. Also, there is no fee for a demolition permit. Amendment needed to the fee table in current zoning.

Section 2-2 (c): Phillips recommended in line 2 to "submit a copy pertaining to new home construction or changes".

Section 2-2 (d): Possible addition of "where applicable" on line three where additional documentation is noted.

Does the whole Town Council have to approve every building permit? This needs to be clearer. Situations such as roof leaks, etc... May not make it practical to wait until a Town Council meeting.

Sec. 2-2 (e)(3): Addition of language saying it must comply to Sussex County laws/regulations regarding swimming pool fencing and safety issue.

Sec 2-2 (e)(5): Addition of "for seasonal or yearly use".

Sec 2-2 (e)(6): Addition of "regardless of type of roofing material used"

Sec 2-2 (e)(7) Addition of "or any new addition"

Sec 2-2 (e)(10): Addition of "whether field or roof application"

Sec 2-2 (e)(11): After varieties "or material type used"

There was question about enforcement and penalties. Murray recommended that we get the ordinance done, and then work on the enforcement.

Phillips recommended that we do a mailing to let residents know of this change and new lower fees.

There was a question about whether a building permit is needed for a dock. Murray thinks that it is a DNREC issue but Sussex County is also involved. It is appropriate to add a dock.

Phillips did the first reading of Ordinance 9A-3.0. Ordinance 10-3-2016.

Phillips thought that this seemed to refer only to new home construction. Murray said that we should specify that it is for new home construction in the title of the ordinance.

Sussex County does not inspect any structure under 400 square feet and that could include a lot of situations. The section that this in in the Land Use Ordinance does pertain to new construction.

Last line of the ordinance will be deleted as the Town does not issue a Certificate of Occupancy.

Murray did a reading the proposed Amendment to Table 2 of Ordinance 2012-10-2012. An Act to amend Table 2 of The Town of Bethel Land Use Ordinance Relating to Fees"

There was one building permit for Mr. Jack Chadwick for a fence.

Road Paving Update: All the paving is done. The trenching of the road in anticipation of the work is a cause for concern and whether the town is liable. If we don't fill in on the town road, and someone gets hurt, what is the town's liability. The road did taper down. Some streets are fine but some streets have 4 or 5 inches. Back fill and grading. It will be over \$5,000 so we have to get bids. McCoy suggested another meeting this month. McCoy made a motion to have a meeting Tuesday, October 18 at 7:00 PM to go over the game plan for the back fill, and we will do the street signs the same day. Motion was never seconded but Secretary's note Meeting was held on Oct. 18, 2016.

Due to time constraints, the Street Signs will be addressed at the Oct. 18, 2016 meeting.

Planning & Zoning: There are two (2) active members of the Planning & Zoning Commission, Tom McCoy and Robin Campfield. We need to solicit for members of the Planning & Zoning. We want to address zoning issues after the first of the year.

Board of Election: First reading of an Ordinance of the Board of Elections (copy attached) by McCoy/Murray. Suggested that any dismissal be by a vote of the Town Council. Discussion of that misconduct is not clarified in the ordinance and could include anything. Perhaps needs to be more specific. Any misconduct "may" result in dismissal was offered at a possible. Misconduct related to the election process or electioneering.

Grass Cutting: Still no bill from Mow'n Trim.

Old/New Business: Letter to Mr. Dukes and Mr. Richardson that should be signed for all was recommended by Hastings.

Suggestion of a backup signature for the checks was made by Salisbury University.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:50 PM.
